COURSE DESCRIPTION

The AMI Montessori 6-12 Orientation Course is designed to give an overview of the 6-12 children and is an introduction to the developmental characteristics and needs of children of this age. It supports an understanding of this developmental stage of life and the Montessori philosophy regarding children of this age.

The course format offers live online lecture presentations, discussion, reading and practical activities for a total of 60 hours.

AWARD

Successful participation in all Orientation Course Requirements leads to the award of the internationally recognized AMI 6-12 Orientation Course Certificate.

WHO IS THE COURSE FOR?

This course is suitable for any adult who wants to better understand the Montessori approach to elementary education, including parents, grandparents and carers; professionals working with children - teachers, student teachers, specialist teachers and school administrators.

The course is a solid starting point for the future Montessori professionals.

The course is a good foundation for new assistants in the Montessori Elementary classroom and can serve as a refresher for current assistants.

GOALS AND BENEFITS OF THE COURSE

- To acquire general knowledge of the Montessori approach to development and education
- To learn about developmental needs and characteristics of the 6-12 children
- To gain knowledge on the prepared environment in Montessori elementary
- To explore how an adult can best support the optimal development of children of this age
- To understand the general importance of observation and learn to observe.

Outside of this course schedule, participants will undertake **9 hours of observation of the elementary children** (can be done in a Montessori school, traditional school, after school programs and activities for elementary children etc).

Specific instructions on how to conduct Observation will be given during the Course.

ZOOM SESSIONS and CANVAS LMS

The live lectures will be delivered via the Zoom platform.

Participants need access to a computer with speakers, a microphone, and a good internet connection. Participation with the camera on is required during Zoom sessions.

All the required readings (with translations), assignments, videos and instructions for the independent work will be available via Canvas LMS, which is easy to access and use.
